



## Dear Parents and Carers,

I wanted to write to thank you all for your incredible support during another fantastic year. We made it! The teachers and Nursery staff have been busy preparing for September: classrooms have been tidied, displays are refreshed and names are on books in readiness for excited pupils in new classes. It's now time for these staff to spend quality time with their families, switch off and recharge ready to go again.

Our wonderful support staff have also been busy completing end of term arrangements and preparing everything for September. The school and grounds are looking amazing as always. The School Office is now working reduced hours but emails and voicemails are being checked. If you need to make contact with the school over the Summer holidays, please leave a message with the School Office and don't contact teachers directly. Thank you. Please be patient as staff will be taking their holidays.

I'm fortunate to be the Headteacher of a school where children want to be, and where parents want their children to learn. Thank you for keeping your children in school and thank you to your children for their love of learning. The national average attendance rate in UK primary schools this academic year was 96%, much higher than last year. Our totals are below:

The majority of our absences are due to illness; thanks for keeping our community safe and your children at home. However, we have had a much higher than national level of holiday absence this year. The children have also performed exceptionally well in their end of term assessments. All year groups have outperformed the national average and as a school we continue to work over 10 standardised score points above the national average. I'm pleased to share the current performance of our whole school with you. These are mean average scores of every child in school:

- Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar 110
- Science 112

I'm incredibly proud of the children and their teachers. I hope you are too. I'm always happy to talk to parents about assessments and data, so do ask if you have any questions. But remember that what we do really well is find the talents, skills and interests of your child beyond a test.
